## Automatic Cancellation of Auxiliary Licenses

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On February 1, 2006, the Commission will implement a new system that automatically cancels auxiliary licenses where the construction deadline has passed without the required notice of completion having been filed.

A construction deadline is the date by which a station is required to be built or meet a coverage requirement. Construction deadlines apply to both new stations as well as stations that have requested modifications to existing facilities. Commission rules require that a licensee notify the Commission within 15 days of completing construction of an auxiliary facility.

Please take the time to review all your auxiliary licenses to ensure that they do not have an outstanding construction deadline. Please also confirm that your auxiliary licenses contain correct contact information, as the Commission will send notification of a pending cancellation to the contact person listed on a license.

This site will allow you to search your licenses by call sign, FRN or licensee name.

If any of your licenses have upcoming construction deadlines, please contact us to discuss the procedures for filing a construction notice. If any of your stations have an expired construction notice, please contact us immediately so that we can prepare a waiver request to prevent their licenses from being cancelled when the new system is implemented on February 1.
